Voting CGT means voting for your rights!

The CGT has helped undocumented workers to organise for many years, whilst at the same time pointing out that whole sections of the economy would be paralysed without migrant workers – whether they hold residence permits or not.

These workers are currently on the front line, in the midst of a severe health crisis. The CGT calls for the protection of all migrants and homeless people, State medical aid for all in order to ensure treatment for everyone, the closure of detention centres and a moratorium on arrests and deportations from French soil.

As regards more specifically workers who hold a residence permit, employers too often take advantage of their situation and do not afford them same rights, because employers know that these workers need to keep their jobs if they want to keep their status. This is illegal and it must change!

As it has always done, and more so in the current context, the CGT calls for the regularisation of undocumented workers, equal rights for all at the work place, as well as protection and health and safety for all workers.

Do you work for a private employer? Are you involved in home help, child care or caretaking? Do you work in a company with less than 11 employees in the food trade, small retailing, hairdressing salons, medical and dental practices, chemists, consulting firms, small theatres, sports, entertainment or the voluntary sector, garages, hotels, cafés or restaurants, building, steelworks...?

Today, you have an opportunity to express yourself and vote CGT in the upcoming elections for representatives of very small businesses, to be held from 22 March to 6 April 2021.

We can only gain new rights if we organise solidarity between all workers!

Vote CGT to have more weight with public authorities and employers, to defend your rights and improve your situation.
